OPERATIONAL

Facility Protection and protocols that will keep your facility, your critical systems, and your personnel safer. Staff training and team building. Travel What you need to know about safe traveling, including air travel, trains and buses, and defensive driving. Safe and unsafe behavior in public places, such as terminals, theaters, stadiums, public lavatories, during arrival and departure, in transit, and in the course of daily activities.

Hotels What you need to know about the security of your travel plans, including your hotel, your reservation, your itinerary, your hotel room location, your travel to and from the hotel, and much more.

Bombs and Other Lethal Devices What to look for. Identifying suspicious objects and what to do when you see one. What to do before (preparation), during (protection), and after (returning to normal) a bomb attack.

Personal Safety How to identify potential assassination or kidnapping attempts against you. Training in simple assault-response techniques that can save your life and the lives of your family.

Threats Who are the individuals and groups you need to know about and what does the most recent intelligence say about their current activities and plans?

Corporate Security Keeping your operations safe and secure from internal sabotage or workplace violence, including identifying vulnerabilities in fleet and supply chain security, hiring practices, and practices arising from corporate culture.
